



Students are expected to make reasonable and steady academic progress. This means students must maintain a minimum of 55% each week of enrollment in the grade book. Student agrees to have their learning tools (ex: school issued technology, charger, pen or pencil) with them during class. Teachers are Allotting time during the block schedule for students to complete all tasks to demonstrate mastery of content. DVUSD Pathways teachers will not accept any late or missing course work after Thursday of Week 3. There are no "early" exams. No credit will be awarded to students who fail to attend on the final assessment day.

Attendance is a critical component of academic success. Students are expected to be in their seats by 12:00 pm or 3:45 pm for their scheduled block. Students are graced two absences per enrollment period. Students who accrue a 3rd absence may be withdrawn from the program. A student may file an Appeal of Withdraw should 3rd absence be accrued in a class. An absence is a "No Show" or a tardy greater than 10 minutes from the class start time.

: Each student agrees to create a positive learning environment free from distractions. DVUSD dress code expectations apply at DVUSD Pathways. Students who fail to dress within the DVUSD dress code will be given a t-shirt to wear during class to be returned at the end of the class period. Students who do not return provided t-shirt will be charged a \$20.00 fee to their student account. Classroom technology is for the sole purpose of learning process within the guidelines of the classroom content and teacher direction. Students using technology for non-academic purposes will be considered off task and a misuse of technology. Misuse of electronic devices may result in removal from the program.
